**CERTIFICATION OF ELECTION RESULTS**

Mayor Moore opened the meeting and turned the meeting over to the City Clerk.

Clerk McKamey stated that there were a total of 264 ballots cast: 132 voted in favor of repealing Ordinance 2005-08 and 132 voted against repealing Ordinance 2005-08. The Clerk stated that a recount was in progress.

Mayor Moore called a recess until the recount was completed.

Mayor Moore reconvened the meeting and the City Clerk stated that the recount had come back with the same totals. Commissioner Anderson asked if a manual count could be taken and Mayor Moore stated she would recess the meeting one more time until after the manual count was completed.

Commissioner Loar left the room.

The meeting was reconvened and the Deputy City Clerk stated that the manual recount was completed and the vote was the same: 132 in favor of repealing Ordinance 2005-08 and 132 against repealing Ordinance 2005-08.

**Commissioner Nadeau made a Motion to Certify the Election Results and Commissioner Goldman seconded the Motion.**

**On roll call vote, YES: Goldman, Anderson, Nadeau, Moore**

The Motion passed with a 4-0 vote.

Mayor Moore stated that Ordinance 2005-08 failed for lack of a majority vote.

The meeting adjourned at 8:10 PM.
