

RESOLUTION 21-06

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, FLORIDA, AMENDING APPENDIX B, SECTION 3, TABLE 1 – H. POLICE SERVICE FEES – SPECIAL DUTY PAY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Commission of Bellevue, Florida has established certain fees for Police Services and related activities; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bellevue has set forth such fees in Appendix B, Section 3, Table 1-H of the City Code; and

WHEREAS, the City Code provides that the rates and fees for Police Services and related activities which are set forth in Appendix B may be amended from time to time by resolution of the City Commission; and

WHEREAS, after Public Hearing, the City Commission of the City of Bellevue has determined that said fees represent the reasonable cost for such services and it is in the best interest of the public welfare to amend said fees as set forth below and to revise Table 1.H. regarding Police Service fees for Special Duty to reflect said amended fees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Commission of Bellevue, Florida hereby amends its Police Service Fees, authorized in Chapter 3, Table 1.H. Police Service Fees – Special Duty Pay be amended as follows:

Special Duty Fees – 2 Hour Minimum:

Basic Detail: Officer:.....	\$40.00 / Hour
City Vehicle:	\$5.00 / Hour
Holiday Detail:	\$50.00 / Hour
City Vehicle:	\$5.00 / Hour

EFFECTIVE DATE. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption by the City Commission of the City of Bellevue, Florida.
