WHEREAS, Chapter 683.01(j) of the Florida Statutes, designates April 26, 2018 as Confederate Memorial Day and the month of April as Confederate History Month; and

WHEREAS, the State of Florida, through its legal representatives voted to secede from the Union of States on January 10, 1861; and

WHEREAS, State of Florida supplied the greatest percentage of its population than any other State and which one third of its soldiers did not return after four terrible years of war; and

WHEREAS, through the diligence, hard work and many sacrifices of its soldiers and citizens, Florida became a vital breadbasket for the other Southern States; and


WHEREAS, 2018 is the eighth year of the Sesquicentennial, the war for Southern Independence, is being observed across this Nation by many States; and


