

RESOLUTION 24-14

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF BELLEVIEW, FLORIDA, ESTABLISHING A YOUTH COUNCIL; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that it is in the public interest for the Mayor/Commissioner to establish a Youth Council comprised of local high school students; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission's desire to establish the council to educate the members on the importance of participating in local government, to build an environment allowing the open discussion of ideas and matters of interest that would benefit the youth of the community, and select group projects that benefit the community.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Commission of the City of Belleview, that the Mayor/Commissioner is hereby authorized to establish a Youth Council.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that the Youth Council should be open to all who wish to participate and the goals, among others, may include the following:

- (1) Meet on a monthly basis during the school term;
- (2) Discuss challenges, needs, and suggested improvements for our community, especially youth;
- (3) Participate in projects as a group that will enhance youth activities.
- (4) Participate in educational programs about city operations, civic responsibility and good citizenship.
- (5) Evaluate and respond to inquiries by the City Commission regarding issues facing youths in our community.
