

ORDINANCE 2024-13

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 126-6 REGARDING TEMPORARY SIGNS TO PROVIDE STANDARDS AND REQUIREMENTS REGARDING FLAGS, BANNERS AND PENNANTS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Section 126-6 (4) of the City Code provides permitting requirements for certain temporary signs; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that it is in the public interest to amend Section 126-4 (4) to add subsection b. regarding Flags, and to add subsection c. regarding banners and pennants, as provided herein-below.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Commission of the City of Belleview, Florida that Section 126-6 (4) of the City Code is amended to provide subsections (b) regarding flags and subsection (c) regarding banners and pennants, which subsections shall read as follows:

Section 126-6. Temporary signs.

(4) Signs allowed, no permit required.

b. Flags

1. *Flag* means a temporary sign consisting of a piece of cloth, fabric, or other non-rigid material. National flags, flags of political subdivision and symbolic flags of any institution or business are examples of a flag.
2. *Pennant* means any flag like piece of cloth, plastic, or paper attached to any staff, cord, building or other structure that hangs loosely for the purpose of attracting attention to the site.
3. For each parcel in a multi-family residential or non-residential districts three flags not greater than 24 square feet in sign area (each) may be displayed on flagpoles. Two flagpoles are allowed for each parcel in the city that is zoned for multi-family residential or non-residential use, not to exceed 35 feet in height.

c. Banners and pennants.

1. *Banner sign* means signs either with or without frames, possessing characters, letters, illustrations or ornamentations applied to cloth, paper or fabric of any kind. For the purposes of this chapter, national flags, flags of political subdivision and symbolic flags of any institution or business shall not be considered banners.
2. One banner sign may be displayed on a temporary basis for no more than 30 consecutive calendar days and no more than 90 total calendar days per year. A maximum of two pennants may be displayed on each parcel. However, all pennants shall be removed and brought indoors at the end of day and during inclement weather.”

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
