City of Belleview Launches Child Safety Program Series Sponsored by New York Life Insurance Company

These ID cards are fully compliant with the AMBER Alert system and are created using the EZ Child ID System, the nation's most comprehensive child fingerprinting system.

This program empowers parents with the tools and information they need to protect their children in case of an emergency. By providing these ID cards, we are taking proactive steps to safeguard our most vulnerable citizens."
