

ORDINANCE 2024-15

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING APPENDIX B, SECTION 3. H REGARDING WATER AND SEWER SERVICE CHARGES TO INCREASE THE CHARGE FOR WATER AND SEWER USE; PROVIDING FOR INCREASES YEARLY FOR FIVE YEARS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Section 86-40 establishes charges regarding water and wastewater (sewer) use; and

WHEREAS, Section 86-43 provides for a 50% surcharge regarding water and wastewater (sewer) use outside the corporate limits of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City engaged Raftelis Financial Consultants, Inc. (Raftelis) to review the City's current charges for water and sewer and, based on current and projected costs, to advise regarding charges necessary to meet anticipated cost to operate and maintain these systems; and

WHEREAS, based upon its study, Raftelis recommends that the rate increases that are necessary to meet the cost of debt service and operating and maintaining these systems; and

WHEREAS, in consideration of recommendations in the Raftelis study, current usage reporting requirements and billing practices the City Commission finds that rather than charging per 1,000 gallons of water used, the charge for water usage should be a charge based upon actual usage, as is set forth in Exhibit "A";

WHEREAS, the City Commission has accepted and approved the Raftelis report, including the findings and recommendations contained therein; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that it is in the public interest to increase the City's charge for water and sewer use in the amount recommended by Raftelis and set forth herein-below.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Commission of the City of Belleview, Florida that Appendix B, Table H of the City Code is amended to increase the charges for water over the next 5 years, as set forth below, which shall read as follows:

“APPENDIX B - FEES

H. Water and Sewer Service Rates:

Water and Sewer Billing Rates as authorized in Chapter 86, Sections 86-40 and 86-43 of the City of Belleview Code that Appendix B – Fees, Table 3 – Public Works Fees, Section - H – Water and Sewer Rates is amended to increase charges use as set forth in Exhibit “A” below.
