### **City of Belleview Launches Monthly Homeschool Hub Program to Support Local Homeschool Families**

Beginning Wednesday, January 8, 2025, the program will take place on the second Wednesday of each month from 10:00 AM to 2:00 PM at the Belleview Community Center.

Each month features a new theme with workshops and hands-on activities, a light lunch and time for children and parents to connect with others.

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### **2025 Homeschool Hub Monthly Topics and Dates**

1. **January 8 – Winter Science Fair**  
Participants will explore the wonders of science through hands-on experiments.
2. **February 12 – Art & Expression**  
Local artists will lead workshops on creativity and self-expression through art.
3. **March 12 – Civic Engagement and Community Service**  
Students will learn about local government and participate in a community service project.
4. **April 9 – Nature & Outdoor Exploration**  
A walk around Lake Lillian including lessons on local ecosystems will bring science to life.
5. **May 14 – STEM Adventure**  
Exciting challenges in STEM fields (Science, Technology, Engineering and Math) will spark young minds.
6. **June 11 – Cultural Celebration**  
Explore global cultures through food, music, and crafts in a vibrant celebration.
7. **July 9 – Fitness & Sports Fun**  
Sports clinics and team-building activities promote health and teamwork.
8. **August 13 – Back-to-School Book Club Kick-Off**  
Storytelling sessions and reading challenges will foster a love of literature.
9. **September 10 – History & Heritage**  
Dive into Belleview’s rich history with guest historians and creative projects.
10. **October 8 – Fall Harvest & Agriculture**  
Celebrate autumn with planting activities, crafts, and seasonal treats.

**11. November 12 – Gratitude & Giving**

Create care packages and discuss the importance of gratitude and community giving.

**12. December 10 – Winter Celebration & Year in Review**

A festive finale with music, crafts, and a reflection on the year's learning.
